Dear Members,

The Commission indicated a list of actions in its intervention, aimed at protecting the proper functioning of the single market, which includes the free movement of transport workers, 'green corridors' - priority lanes for freight transport, flexibility for rules on driving and rest times and pre-notification of national measures to the Commission. A full press release can be found on the <u>HR Presidency website</u>.

Moreover, the Commission has provided an **overview of the restrictions to transport, such as travel restrictions and border controls, imposed by different EU Member States**. You can find a full list by country on the <u>DG MOVE website</u>. This list is being updated regularly.

We have also received some internal information on traffic restrictions at EU borders, giving an update on the situation in different Member States, last updated yesterday morning. For more infomation, please refer to the documents attached to this Circular. However, please keep in mind that the situation is changing every day as well as the information provided.

Another useful tool that came to our attention is a **live map of border crossing times for trucks**, which provides aggregated information based on real-time data. It can be accessed for free via the sixfold website.
